### Chairman's Report

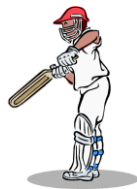
The Cricket season is here again and I have to say that, on the approach to the village, the Club field looks brilliant. The veranda is now complete and to my mind, adds to our great facility.
